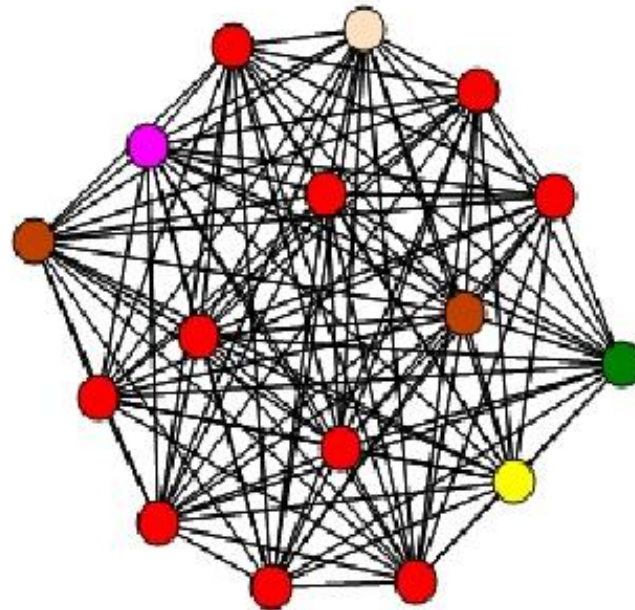

How frequently does your organization work with organization XYZ on issues related to the NH Regional Network's goals?

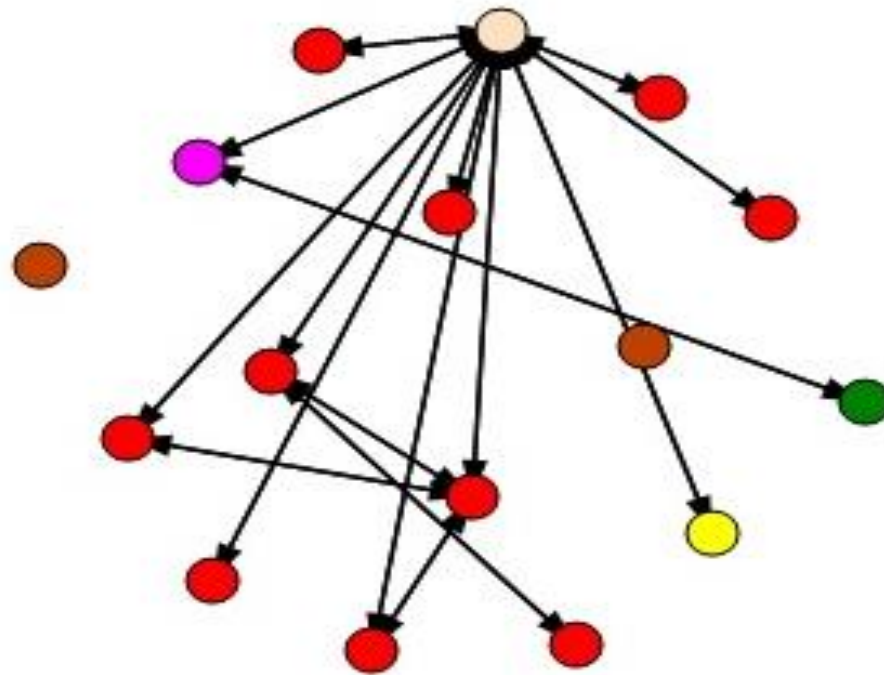

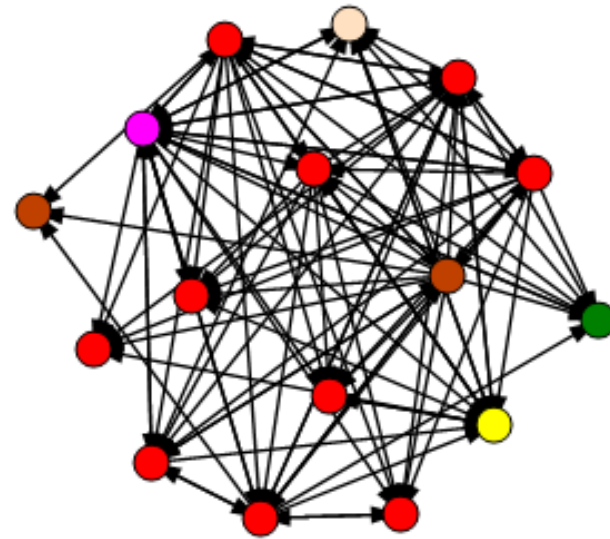

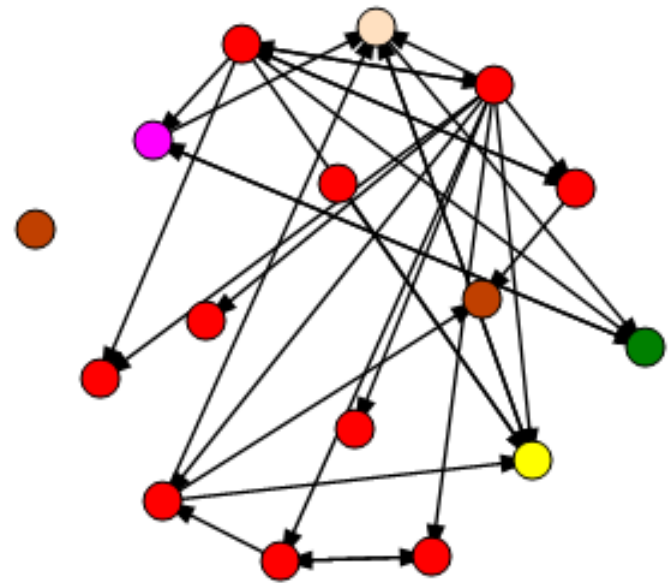

Integrated Activities

Network Scores

Density:

Percentage of ties present in the network in relation to the total number of possible ties in the entire network.

97.10%

Degree Centralization

The lower the centralization score, the more similar the members are in terms of their number of connections to others (e.g. more decentralized).

3.30%

Trust

The percentage of how much members trust one another. A 100% occurs when all members trust others at the highest level

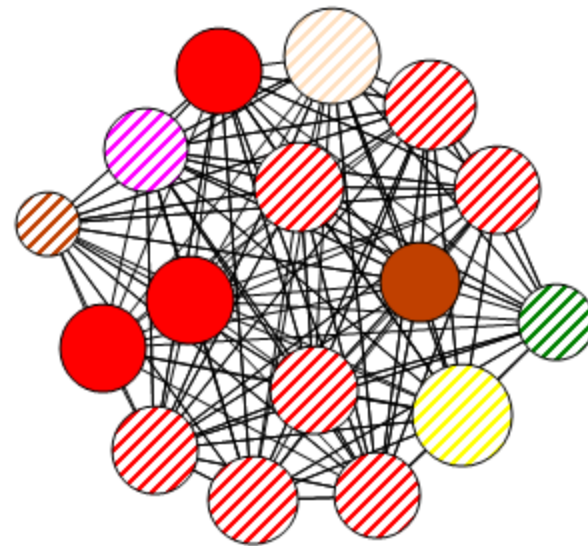

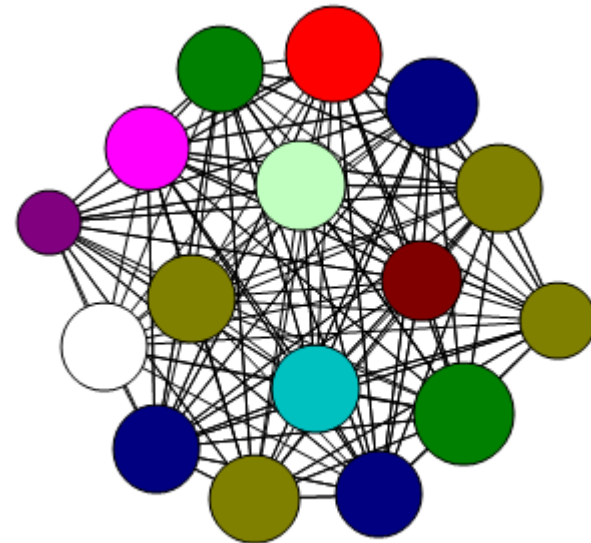

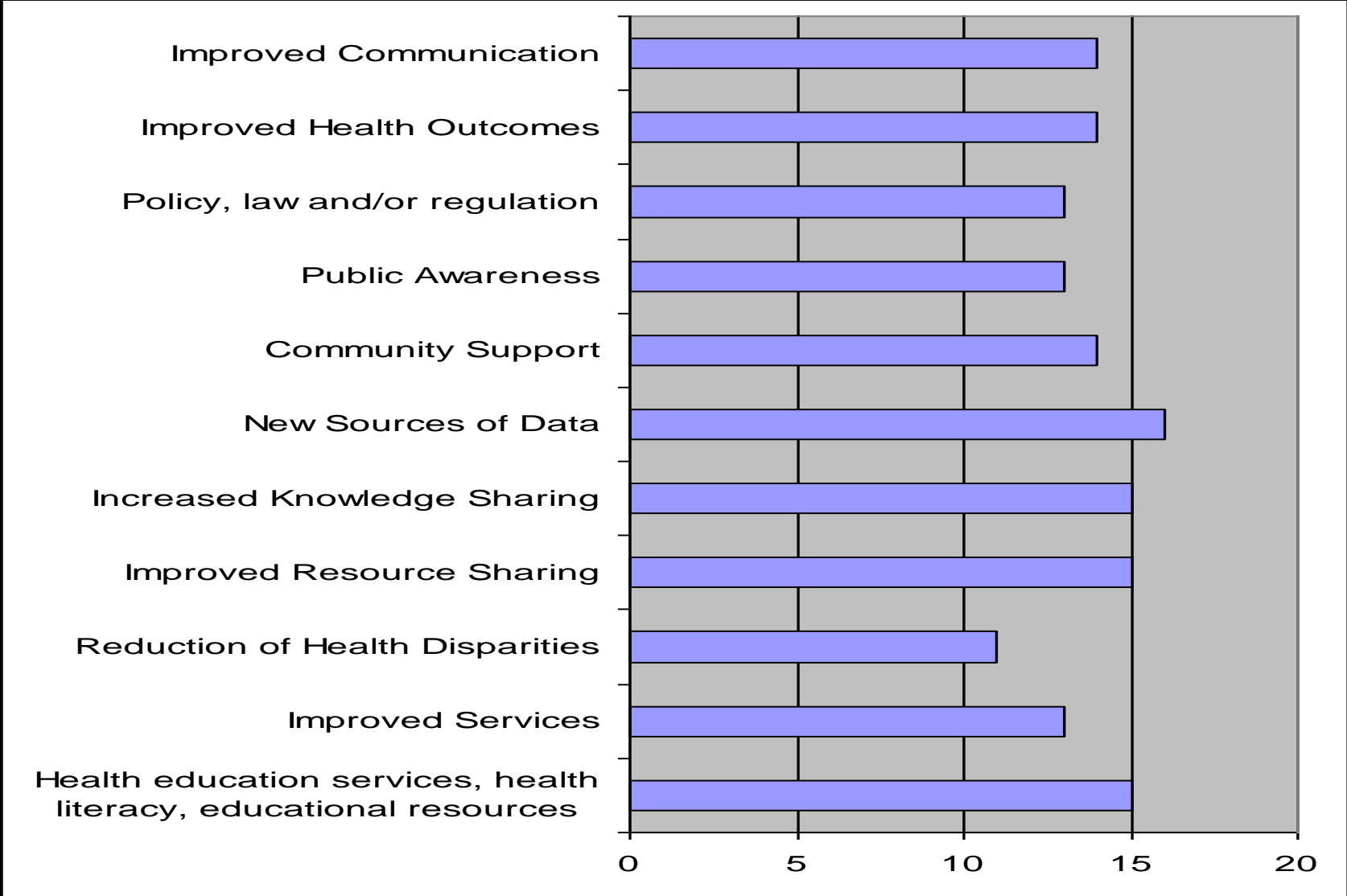

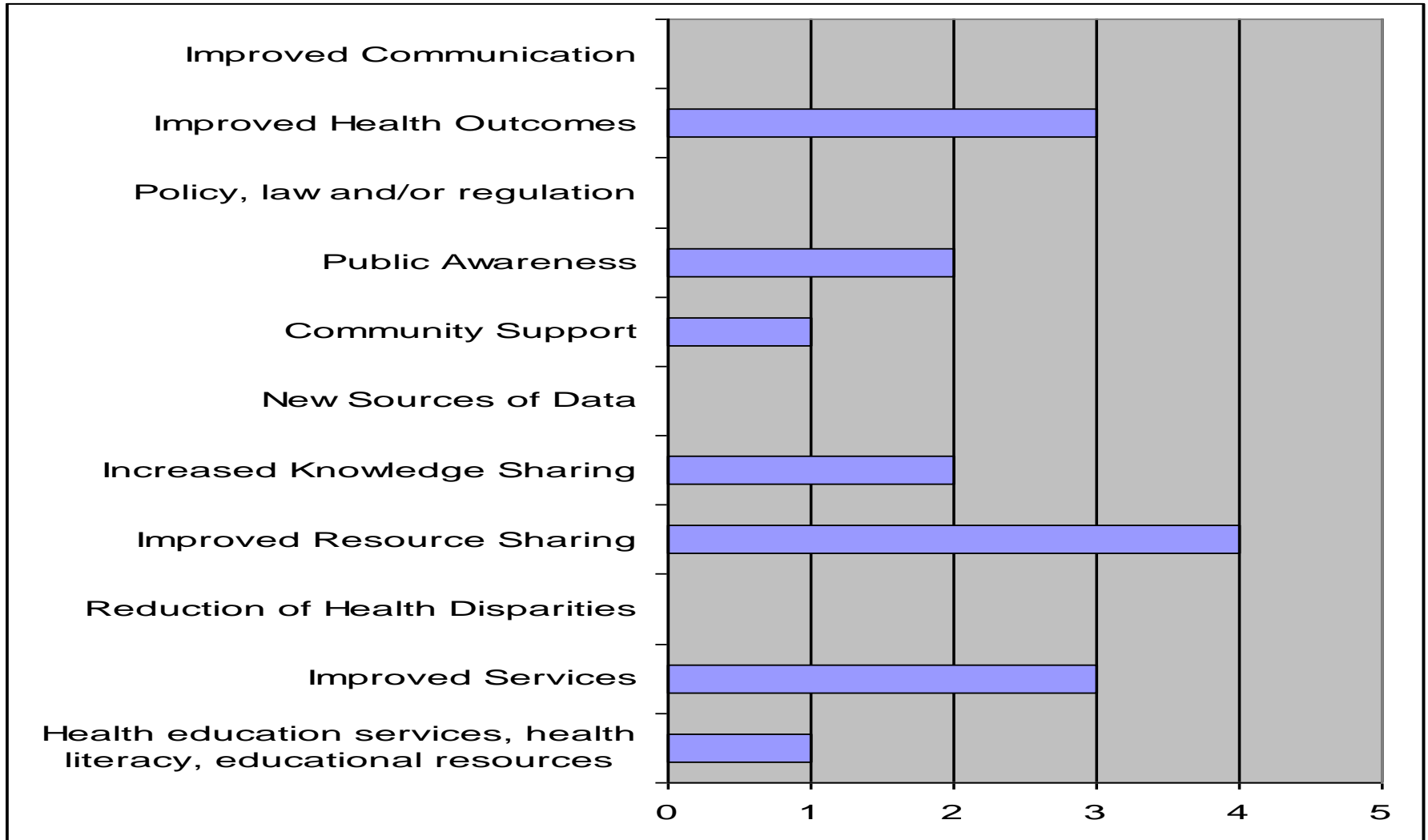

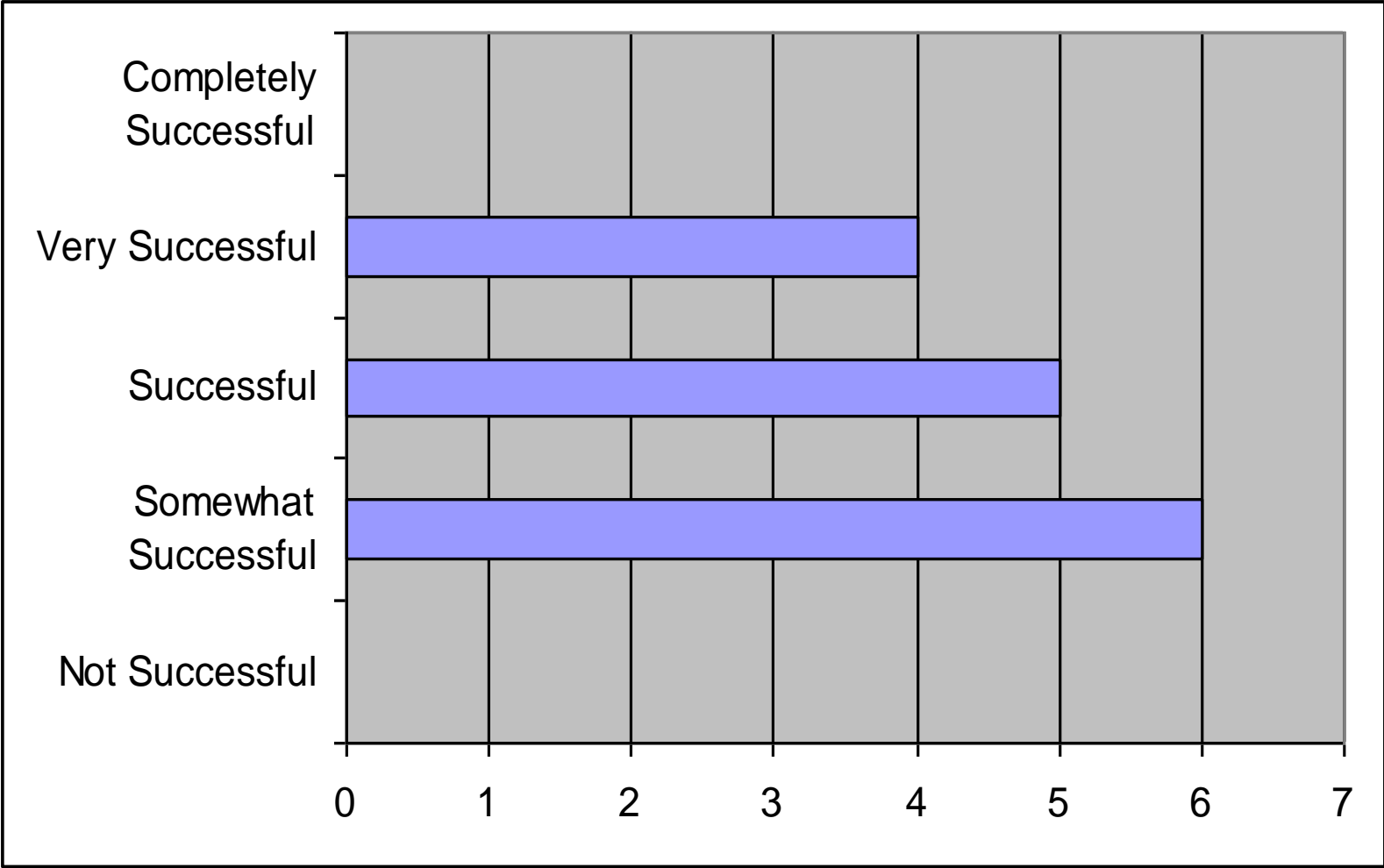
Outcomes of the NH Regional Network's work include, or could potentially include: (choose all that apply). (n=16)
